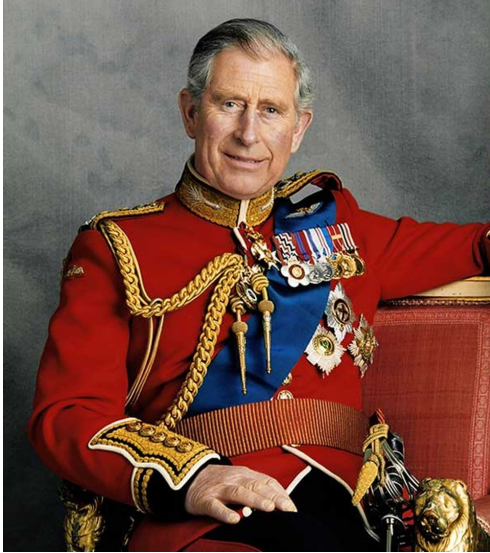

Reporting Absence



Please report child absences using the Willows PA Connect app.

The school must be informed **EVERY** school day that the child is absent.

Please ensure that you have reported your child's absence **by 9.00am**.

Attendance fact of the week:

Missing a few days of school here and there may not seem a big deal, but research shows that it can have a significant impact on children's learning. Children who miss a substantial amount of school fall behind their peers, and struggle to catch up.

Most of the work they miss is never made up, which can lead to big gaps in their learning.

Poor attendance often starts at primary school, and children who fall into this pattern are likely to underachieve at secondary school.

Pupils who miss between **10** and **20%** of school (**that's 19 to 38 days per year**) stand only a **35%** chance of achieving five or more good GCSEs, compared to **73%** of those who miss fewer than **5%** of school days.
