Reception News

This week has been a busy week! We have had lots of different topics to cover this week and the children have completed some amazing activities.

To start the week we had 'Odd Sock Day', we celebrated how everyone is the same but different. We designed our own odd socks, reading 'Simon's Socks' and played matching sock activities.

We took part in lots of Remembrance Day activities in class including poppy painting, CVC word writing and decorating our own poppy pictures.

We then moved on to look at kindness and how we can be kind to each other, we recognised how kind actions can make other feel and how it is important to be kind. We designed our own kindness posters, to join in with a whole school competition. This then tied in with anti-bullying week and how we need to ensure we are respectful and kind to one another.

In maths this week we have been focusing on recognising and representing numbers 4 and 5. We then looked at ordering numbers 0 to 10 and above.

Challenges!

Reading: Children need to be reading at least 5 times at home. Please record all reading in their reading books. We count reads on a Thursday.

Bedtime story: Every Friday a recorded bedtime story will be published on Tapestry, read by one of our team for you and your child to enjoy together. This can be recorded as a 'read' in your child's reading record.

Phonics: Each week we will send home a phonics video for your child to watch and join in with at home recorded by one of the EYFS team. Please complete the activities and share your work on Tapestry.

Tapestry: Don't forget to add your adventures to Tapestry—the children love sharing their photos on the big board and this really helps to support their speaking and listening skills.

Weekly Routines

PE will be inside on Monday afternoons, please send your child to school in their PE kit every Monday.

Reading books—Reading books will be changed weekly. Reading books and diaries should be bought into school everyday. Other books can be recorded in you child's reading record.

Library books—Our library sessions takes place each Friday. Please make sure your child returns their book each week in order to choose a new one .

- Application Method: You can apply online through your local council or use the application form provided by the council.

 - •Check Preferences: Make sure to use all four of your preferences to increase your chances of securing a place at your preferred school.
 - •Offers: Offers will be sent to online applicants by email on 16 April 2026.
