- •Check Preferences: Make sure to use all four of your preferences to increase your chances of securing a place at your preferred school.

Reporting Absence

Please report your child's absence to the office by emailing admin@willows.essex.sch.uk or by leaving a message on the office telephone by calling 01268 470880.



The school must be informed **EVERY school day** that the child is absent.

Please ensure that you have reported your child's absence by 9.20am.

Lateness

We are recently noticing a large number of children arriving late to school without an agreed arrival time.

This will impact your child's overall percentage of attendance.

Persistent lateness to school can significantly
disrupt academic performance, social dynamics, and overall students well-being, leading to long term, negative
consequences.

Whilst we understand that there are certain situations where this cannot be helped, it is important that you keep communicating with us. This is to help us better understand, or to be able to help with the improvement of late arrivals, addressing any barriers that may be contributing to this. If your child arrives to school after the gates have closed, or if they have an agreed later start time, you must accompany them to enter school via the office. You must sign them & support them in using our InVentry console in the reception area. You will be asked to give a reason for their lateness, please make sure you complete this accurately, as it is recorded on your child's attendance.

If a later arrival time <u>has not</u> been agreed, should your child arrive after 9am, they will be marked as <u>'U'</u> on the register. Any arrivals after 9.25am are marked as <u>'U'</u>, which goes down as a missed/unauthorised mark!

PLEASE BE REMINDED THE SCHOOL GATES CLOSE 9AM PROMPTLY!

If you or your child have an appointment, or know that you will be arriving to school late for any other reason, <u>please inform the office via email your child's lunch choice for that day</u>. This is so the kitchen can be provided with the correct number of lunches. Should we not receive your lunch choice, we cannot guarantee your child will be able to have their preferred option.

Should your child's choice be baguette, please state which filling they would like to have.

At The Willows, we pride ourselves on the multiple lines of communication that we offer. Here is a simple guide on how to best use them!

The Willows Parents App (PA Connect)

The place where you can find everything!

You can use the app to:

- Check menus
- Check upcoming dates
- Look at calendar events & term dates
- · Notify us of an absence, a medical appointment or to request a holiday
 - Pay for trips/events



Class Charts

This is to communicate directly with your child's teacher for all non-urgent things. You can use this to:

- Notify your child's teacher directly of something that is not urgent (lost items etc)
 - · Ask a non-urgent question (e.g. Ask about a trip that is the future)
- Inform the teacher of something about your child that may help support them (e.g. A pet passed away and they may be upset)

How to get a message to the right person.



This is to be used for all urgent and confidential enquiries! For example:

- To notify us of anything urgent (e.g. Late pick ups, changes to adults picking up, absences if you cannot use the app)
 - Notify us of anything confidential (safeguarding, personal information)
 - · Ask to speak with SLT or the Inclusion Team about your child
- · Ask a question about something wider than your child's class (e.g. Staffing, Health & Safety etc)
 - Speak with someone about a concern that you have
 - Talk to us about anything financial

Using the correct method of communicating with us will hugely improve the speed in which we can deal with your issue as it will go the right person at the right time!
